Training Locations & Registration: We offer trainings in about 8 – 12 locations each year, some of which are private trainings. Previous attendees have described our trainings as transformative and life changing experiences. Given the locations of our trainings, we encourage you to plan on traveling to one of our trainings rather than waiting for one to be scheduled nearby. Business Formation: Developing and operating an EAL business is the same as any other business and there are many aspects to be considered beyond the EAL programs with clients.

EAL Academy will support you by providing information that's specific to EAL, based on our 20+ years of providing EAL programs. With our certification training, we provide specific information about managing equine liability risk and equine liability insurance, marketing, pricing, and selling EAL programs, and a complete set of tools, templates, forms, and samples that take you from providing a prospective client a sales proposal and all the way through the aspects of conducting an EAL program. Our clients say, "it's EAL business in a box."

We recommend utilizing the sba.gov and other local resources such as the Chamber and/or other Business Development organizations, along with an attorney and a CPA to establish your business legal structure (profit or nonprofit, LLC or Inc., formation and filings). It's best to complete a business plan with strategies specific to your market. Also, you'll want to determine your approach for technology and accounting needs, including your website, taking payments, social media, etc. These general business management topics aren't covered during our trainings, although we do cover the EAL specific business aspects mentioned above.

Request to Host our Trainings: We receive many generous offers to host our training. We appreciate this interest and want to support everyone's requests. Our best hosting experiences are when we're hosted by someone that has attended our trainings because they thoroughly understand all aspects of the trainings, our approach, our values, and the horse activities. We give preference to those that have invested in us and if you attend one of our trainings then we'll explore the future opportunity to host. If you don't meet these requirements but have enough attendees to fill a training (6 – 12 attendees), then please see the Private Training option described below. Occasionally we're interested in holding trainings in a specific location, and in these situations, we'll consider a host that hasn't attended our trainings if they're experienced with EAL and meet the requirements below.

Overview of Host Facility Requirements for Trainings Offered to the General Public:

- Located within 45 minutes from a major airport with nearby lodging options
- Indoor Meeting Room: Space for training, debriefing, and lunch; 15' x 25' or larger; typically set up with 5 tables and 15 20 chairs for the attendees and trainer; 1 table for materials and snacks
- Horse Activities:
 - Covered arena (60' x 80' or larger, this requirement is waived in areas where covered arenas are typically not found, such as southern CA, AZ, and NV)
 - Round pen (60' or larger) or equipment to partition a corner of the arena
 - Approximately 8+ horses suitable for the EAL ground activities
 - Standard activity equipment such as poles, boards, jumps, barrels, etc.



- Staff and/or volunteers to set up horse activities and handle horses (typically 2 for each horse activity; not required to be present all day and are needed when we're doing horse activities)
- Restroom and supplies
- Lunches: Assist with securing a single caterer to provide a lunch drop off for all days
- Assistance with promoting the trainings with your contacts in the local community, newsletters, website, and social media, to secure a few training attendees
- Preparation Meetings: Meet a couple times virtually to coordinate catering and horse activities at 2 weeks and 4 weeks prior to the trainings, along with meeting the day before the training starts for a few hours

Private Trainings: We offer private trainings for organizations that are interested in having us come to them to train their staff, volunteers, board, and other affiliates. This is a lower cost approach for registration on a per person basis, along with avoiding travel expenses. With this option, we provide a fixed price estimate based on our trainer travel expenses. We will work with you and most of the Host Facility Requirements listed above are not required.

Illustrative example: If our total training cost is \$20,000 for 2 of our trainers to travel to your location to lead both our 4-day certification and 1-day mindfulness and you have 10 attendees, the price would be \$2,000 per person. This is a significant savings on a per person basis for the training registration cost plus saving travel expenses.

I Don't Have a Facility and Horses: You'll need to find your own answer regarding the best time for you to attend our trainings. Here's some aspects to consider:

- Many that attend our trainings don't yet have their own facility and horses. The training
 provides a lot of information and insight for seeing possibilities and/or making decisions
 about facility requirements, location, horse selection, activity equipment, and a partner to
 co-facilitate client programs.
- Many people partner with an equestrian facility to host their EAL programs. During the
 training we can discuss aspects to consider. For our own trainings we work out of other
 equestrian centers, so we'll share our experience and the key points to do this
 successfully.
- It helps to be able to practice facilitation soon after the training, and you may be able to partner with another facility to do this in the meantime.
- If we're conducting a training that's close to you, likely you'll save on travel costs compared to traveling to another location in the future.
